

2022 Accomplishments & Budget

- The agency provided \$491,000 in direct financial assistance, supplies and in-kind support to over 500 individuals. This was another record in the nearly 50year history of the agency.
- In November 2022, the agency was honored with the Nonprofit Legacy Award from the Community Foundation of North Central Florida in recognition of our Transformational Leadership.
- Lead Attorney Brittani Melvin worked with the Alachua County Commission to secure renter rights for survivors by successfully advocating for an ordinance that guarantees landlords will change locks when domestic violence has occurred.
- The Supportive Housing project served 22 families last year, a new record. The Rapid Rehousing project placed 123 families in safe, community-based housing.
- Both the High-Risk Team model and the Abuse in Later Life Project have been renewed!
- Prevention Programming expanded to Zoom and reached their biggest annual audience ever - nearly 11,500 students and educators across the tri-county region.
