Peaceful Paths is the certified domestic violence center serving adult and children in Alachua, Bradford, and Union counties. Services they provide are free and confidential including emergency on-campus shelter and housing, a 24-hour crisis helpline, counseling and support groups for victims and families, victim advocacy, economic empowerment and financial literacy, legal services, professional education and training, violence prevention education, relocation assistance and community awareness.

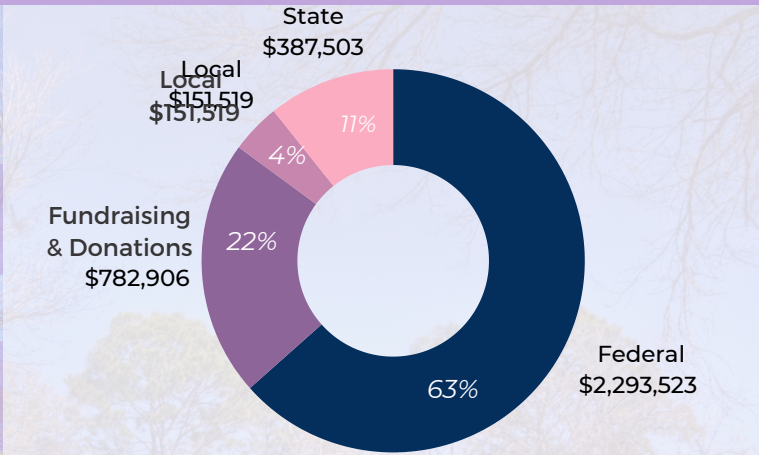
2023 Services Provided Snapshot

2023 Accomplishments & Budget

- The agency provided **\$223,612** in direct financial assistance, supplies and in-kind support.
- Brittani Melvin and her team of legal warriors helped to get **616 injunctions for local survivors**.
- Peaceful Paths served **1935 new persons**.
- The agency helped **37 male survivors** offering a total of **1,696 services** to adult males this year.
- The Supportive Housing project served **38 families last year, a new record!** The Rapid Rehousing project placed **165 families in safe, community-based housing, another new record!**
- Both the **High-Risk Team model** and the **Abuse in Later Life Project** have been renewed!
- Prevention Programming taught **over 9,100 students** this year within the community.
